FIREFIGHTER/PARAMEDIC or FIREFIGHTER/EMT

The Barnstable Fire Department seeks qualified applicants for the full-time position of Firefighter/EMT-Paramedic, Firefighter/EMT-Advanced or Firefighter/EMT-Basic. This is a day-shift position working 4 days on / 4 days off, (10 hours shifts), rotating in conjunction with an existing day position. Applicants must possess current Massachusetts certification as an EMT-Paramedic, EMT-Advanced, or EMT-Basic, and must possess a valid Massachusetts driver's license. High school diploma or equivalent is required; advanced college degree in Fire Science, Paramedicine, or related field is desirable. A minimum of one (1) year of job-related experience is desired. The successful candidate will be required to complete the Massachusetts Firefighting Academy-Career Firefighter Recruit Training Program. The successful candidate will be required to establish residency within ten (10) road miles of the Barnstable Fire Station, within one (1) year of their hire date. Compensation is defined by the Barnstable Firefighters collective bargaining agreement and is dependent upon qualifications; comprehensive benefits provided.

To apply, please submit an application package including a cover letter, resume, completed job application, Criminal Offender Records Inquiry (CORI) authorization form, and copies of current Massachusetts EMT-Paramedic/EMT-Advanced/EMT-Basic certification, Advanced Cardiac Life Support (ACLS) certification (paramedics only), Cardio-pulmonary resuscitation (CPR) certification, and valid Massachusetts Driver's license.
